Chikorita Amigurumi

Materials

- Light green and dark green yarn
- 3.5 mm crochet hook
- fiber-fill stuffing
- Fabric marker and white fabric to draw on (for the eyes)
- Scissors, yarn needle for assembly

Abbreviations

- R(#): Round number

- MR: magic ring

- Sc: single crochet

-dc: double crochet

-tr: triple crochet

- inc: increase (2 sc in same stitch)

- dec: decrease (decrease 2 sc into one)

- f/o: fasten off

Head and Body (light green)

R1. Sc 6 in MR (6)

R2. Inc around (12)

R3. 'Sc 1, inc' around (18)

R3. 'Sc 2, inc' around (24)

R5 - R11 Sc around (24) seven times

R12. Inc 6, sc 18 (30)

R13. 'Sc 1, inc' 5 times, sc 20 (35)

R14. 'Sc 2, inc' 4 times, sc 23 (39)

R15 - R16 Sc around (39) two times

R17. 'Sc 3, inc' 3 times, Sc around 27 (42)

R18. Sc around (42)

R19. 'Sc 5, dec' around (36)

R20. 'Sc 4, dec' around (30)

R21. 'Sc 3, dec' around (24)

R 22. 'Sc 2, dec' around (18)

R33. 'Sc 1, dec' around (12)

(Don't forget stuffing)

Stitch opening closed with yarn needle.

Necklace

Sew dark green 'dots' around neck using yarn needle and dark green yarn.

Feet (light green - make 4)

R1. Sc 4 in MR (4)

R2. Sc 1, inc, sc 1 inc (6)

R3. Sc 1, inc, sc 2, inc, Sc 1 (8)

R4. Sc 2, inc, sc 3, inc, sc 2 (10)

R5. 'Sc 1, inc' around (15)

R6. Sc around (15)

R7. 'Sc 2, inc' around (20) f/o

Tail (light green)

Repeat instructions for feet R1- R4. f/o.

Leaf (dark green yarn)

Chain 16

In 2nd from hook:

sc, hdc, hdc, dc, dc, tr, tr, tr,

dc, dc, hdc, hdc, sc (16)

Then going back along the

chain:

Sc, hdc, hdc, dc, dc, tr, tr, tr, dc, dc, hdc, hdc, sc (16) f/o.

Eyes and Mouth

Using fabric marker on white fabric draw eyes and mouth, cut out with scissors, and glue to head. Of course you could also make using felt pieces or needle felting if you prefer.
