

# Mini Cyndaquil Amigurumi

## Materials

- yarn: yellow, dark blue, red
- 3.5 mm crochet hook
- fiber-fill stuffing
- Black sewing thread and needle (eyes)
- Scissors, yarn needle for assembly
- Hair straightener and comb/brush for flames

## Abbreviations

- **R(#)** : Round number
- **MR**: magic ring
- **ch**: chain
- **tch**: turn chain
- **Sc** : single crochet
- **dc**: double crochet
- **inc**: increase (2 sc in same stitch)
- **dec**: decrease (decrease 2 sc into one)
- **sl st** : slip stitch
- **f/o**: fasten off

## Head and Body (yellow)

- R1.** 6 Sc in MR (6)
- R2.** Inc around (12)
- R3.** 'Sc 1, inc' around (18)
- R4.** 'Sc 2, inc' around (24)
- R5.** 'Sc 3, inc' around (30)
- R6 – R11** Sc around (30) 6 x
- R12.** 'Sc 3, dec' around (24)
- R13.** 'Sc 2, dec' around (18)
- R14.** 'Sc 2, inc' around (24)
- R15.** Sc around (24)
- R16.** 'Sc 3, inc' around (30)
- R17-R19** Sc around (30) 3 x
- R20.** 'Sc 9, inc' around (33)
- R21-R23** Sc around (33) 3 x
- R24.** 'Sc 9, dec' around (30)
- R25.** 'Sc 3, dec' around (24)
- R26.** 'Sc 2, dec' around (18)
- R27.** 'Sc 1, dec' around (12)
- Don't forget to add stuffing.
- R28.** Dec around (6) f/o

## Stripe (dark blue)

- Row 1:** Ch 2, tch (2)
- Rows 2-3:** Sc 2, tch (2) 2 x
- Row 3:** Sc 1, inc, tch (3)
- Rows 4-7:** Sc 3, tch (3) 4 x
- Row 8:** Sc 2, inc, tch (4)
- Rows 9-10:** Sc 4, tch (4) 2 x
- Row 11:** Sc 3, inc, tch (5)
- Row 12:** Sc 5, tch (5)
- Row 13:** Sc 4, inc, tch (6)
- Row 14:** Sc 5, inc, tch (7)
- Rows 15-16:** Sc 7, tch (7) 2 x
- Row 17:** Sc 6, inc, tch (8)
- Rows 18-24:** sc 8, tch (8) 7 x
- Row 25:** sc 6, dec, tch (7)
- Row 26:** inc, sc 5, inc (9)
- Row 27:** sc 9, tch (9)
- Row 28:** sc 8, inc, tch (10)
- Rows 29-32:** sc 10, tch (10) 4 x
- Row 33:** dec, sc 6, dec (8) f/o.

## Snout (yellow)

- R1.** 4 Sc in MR (4)
- R2.** Sc 1, inc, sc 1, inc (6)
- R3.** Sc around (6)
- R4.** Sc 1, inc, sc 2, inc, sc 1 (8)
- R5.** Sc around (8)
- R6.** Sc 1, inc, sc 4, inc, sc 1 (10)
- R7.** Sc around (10)
- R8.** Sc 1, inc, sc 6, inc, sc 1 (12)
- R9.** Sc around (12)
- R10.** Sc 1, inc, sc 8, inc sc 1 (14) f/o.

## Arms (yellow) make 2

- R1.** 4 Sc in MR (4)
- R2.** Sc 1, inc, sc 1, inc (6)
- R3.** Sc around (6)
- R4.** Sc 1, inc, sc 2, inc, sc 1 (8)
- R5-R6.** Sc around (8) 2 times. f/o

## Legs, Feet (yellow)

- R1.** 6 Sc in MR (6)
  - R2.** Inc around (12)
  - R3-R6** Sc ar (12) 4 x
  - R4.** Dec ar (6)
- Feet:  
in next sc on round:  
[sl t, Ch 2, dc]  
in next sc on round:  
[dc, Ch2, sl st] f/o

## Flame

Chain a base of about 4. Fasten on strands of yellow and red yarn ends into the loops. Comb out red and yellow yarn to 'unwind' the yarn. Use a hair straightener on the ends to remove waves.
