

Mini Porygon2 Amigurumi

Materials

- Yarn: Magenta, light blue (ply 3 was used)
- 3.5 mm crochet hook
- fiber-fill stuffing
- Felt (black, white), Felting Needle
- Scissors, yarn needle for assembly

Abbreviations

- **R(#)** : Round number
- **MR**: magic ring
- **Sc** : single crochet
- **Inc**: increase (2 sc in same stitch)
- **Dec**: decrease (decrease 2 sc into one)
- **f/o**: fasten off

Head

Using magenta:

R1. 6 sc in MR (6)

R2. Inc around (12)

R3. Sc 1, inc around (18)

R4-R5. Sc around (18) 2 times

R6. Sc 1, dec around (12)

R7. Dec around (6)

R8-R9. Sc around (6) 2 times.

Leave ring open and f/o leaving a long tail for sewing.

Body

Using magenta:

R1. 6 sc in MR (6)

R2. Inc around (12)

R3. Sc 1, inc around (18)

R4. Sc around (18)

R5. Sc 2, inc around (24)

R6. Sc around (24)

R7. Sc 2, dec around (18)

R8. Sc around (18)

R9. Sc 1, dec around (12)

R10. Dec around (6)

Close ring and f/o.

Tail

Using light blue:

R1. 4 sc in MR (4)

R2. Inc, sc, inc, sc (6)

R3-R4. Sc around (6) 2 times

R5. Inc, sc 5 (7)

R6. Sc around (7)

R7. Dec, sc 5 (6)

R8. Sc around (6)

R9. Dec around (3)

Leave ring open and f/o with a long tail for sewing.

Beak

Using light blue yarn:

R1. 4 sc in MR (4)

R2-R3. Sc around (4) 2 times

R4. Inc, Sc 3 (5)

R5. Inc, sc 4 (6) f/o leaving a tail for sewing.

Wings – make 2

Using light blue:

R1. 6 sc in MR (6)

R2. Sc 2, inc, Sc 2, inc (8)

R3. Sc 3, inc, Sc 3, inc (10)

R4. Sc 3, dec, Sc 3, dec (8)

R5. Sc around (8)

R6. Sc 2, dec, Sc 2, dec (6)

R7. Sc 4, dec (5)

Close ring and f/o.

Belly

Crochet an oval:

R1. Ch 4. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of the next 2 chains (3sc)

Inc in last chain (3sc in last chain)

Continue along the other side of the foundation chain:

Sc 1, Inc. End of R1 (8 sc total)

R2. Inc, sc, inc, inc, inc, sc, inc, inc (14)

R3. Inc, sc 2, 'inc, sc' 3 times, sc, 'inc, sc' 2 times (20)

F/o and leave a long tail for sewing.

Assembly

Sew on the beak to the head.

Of note the body is oriented such that the wings will be positioned one just beneath the starting 'magic ring' of the body and the other just beneath the final finished off circle of the body. Attach the belly to the body first, then add the wings, tail, and head. For the eyes felt pieces were cut to the appropriate shape and attached with fabric glue.
