Scorbunny Amigurumi

Materials

- Yarn: Orange, light orange, white, yellow (ply 3 was used)
- 3.5 mm crochet hook
- fiber-fill stuffing
- Felt (black, red/pink, orange, yellow, white) Felting Needle – for details
- -Black thread, embroidery needle for paws
- Scissors, yarn needle for assembly

Abbreviations

- R(#) : Round number
- MR: magic ring
- Sc : single crochet
- Inc: increase (2 sc in same stitch)
- Dec: decrease (decrease 2 sc into one)
- f/o: fasten off

Head and Body

Using white: R1. 6 sc in MR (6) R2. Inc around (12) **R3.** Sc 1, inc around (18) **R4.** Sc 2, inc around (24) **R5.** Sc 4, inc, inc, Sc 12, inc, inc, Sc 4 (28) R6-8. Sc around (28) three times **R9.** Sc 5, dec, dec, sc 10, dec, dec, sc 5 (24) **R10.** Sc 2, dec around (18) **R11.** Sc 1, dec around (12) **R12.** Dec around (6) Continue on to body: **R13.** Inc around (12) **R14.** Sc 1, inc around (18) R15-R18. Sc around (18) four times **R19.** Sc 1, dec around (12) R20. Dec around (6) Close and f/o.

Ears – make 2

Beginning with orange: **R1.** 4 sc in MR (4) **R2.** Inc, Sc 1, inc, Sc 1 (6) **R3.** Inc, Sc 2, Inc, Sc 2 (8) **R4.** Inc, Sc 3, Inc, Sc 3 (10) **R5.** Sc around (10) Switch to light orange: **R6.** Sc around (10) Switch to white: **R7.** Sc around (10) **R8.** Dec, Sc 3, Dec, Sc 3 (8) **R9.** Sc around (8) **R10.** Dec, Sc 2, Dec, Sc 2 (6) **R11.** Sc around (6)

One ear has a white accent. To make this accent crochet (with white) up the bottom side of one completed ear: sl st, sc, sc, ch hdc chain 3, and join with sl st back to the base - f/o.



Cheeks - make 2

Using white: **R1.** 4 sc in MR (4) **R2.** Sc around (4) **R3.** Inc, Sc 3 (5) **R4.** Sc around (5) chain 3, join with base using a sl st, f/o leaving a tail for sewing.

Scarf

Using orange: Chain 11, then working back (starting on 2nd ch from hook) Slip stitch 10 times. F/o leaving a long tail for sewing.

Arms

Using white: **R1.** 5 sc in MR (5) **R2.** Inc, sc, inc, sc 2 (7) **R3.** Dec, Sc, dec, sc 2 (5) **R4.** Dec, sc 3 (4) **R5-R6.** Sc around (4) two times. F/o leave a long tail for sewing.

Feet – make 2

Starting with orange: **R1.** 6 sc in MR (6) **R2.** Inc, Sc 2, inc, Sc 2 (8) **R3.** Sc around (8) Switch to white: **R4.** Dec, Sc 2, Dec, Sc 2 (6) **R5.** Dec, Sc 4 (5) **R6.** Sc around (5) In next round only work in outer loops (then resume crocheting in the round normally): **R7.** Sc around (5) [in outer loops] **R8-11.** Sc around (5) four times. f/o leave unclosed and a long tail for sewing.

Tail

Using white: **R1.** 5 sc in MR (5) **R2.** Inc around (10) **R3-R4.** Sc around (10) **R5.** Dec around (5) –close ring, f/o.

Assembly

Attach Cheeks, Ears, Arms, Legs, and tail to body. The yellow nose patch was added by surface crocheting a square (done by pulling through yellow yarn on the inside of the work to draw from) and filling in the square with yellow thread using needle felting. The eyes and mouth were also added by needle felting. Finally, embroidery thread was added to each paw to create fingers and toes.
